Roederer Estate Brut Rose

Appellation: Anderson Valley

Tasting Notes: Blend of 60% Pinot Noir & 40% Chardonnay. Full & round with smooth flavors & fine, persistent bubbles. The extra measure of Chardonnay contributes elegance & austerity which balance nicely with the delicate fruitiness of the Pinot Noir. **16/glass**

Scharffenberger Brut NV

Appellation: Mendocino County

Tasting Notes: Notes of freshly baked bread that enhance the more fruit forward style of the wine. Complex aromas of caramel & hazelnut in the finish. **14/glass**

Pey-Marin 2010 Riesling "The Shell Mound"

Appellation: Marin

Tasting Notes: Light bodied citrus and floral flavors. Savory mouth feel, juicy with a good finishing breadth. **12/glass**

Zocker 2010 Gruner Veltliner

Appellation: Edna Valley

Tasting Notes: Rich and round with great acid structure. This wine is steely and has good minerality with a note of white pepper and flavors of ripe melon. **12/glass**

Gewurztraminer

Appellation: Santa Barbara County

Tasting Notes: Lovely aromas of lime blossoms, lychee fruit and spicy rose. The mouthfeel is crisp and lively with tropical fruit and spice notes. **12/glass**

De Sante 2009 Semillon Blend "L'Atelier"

Appellation: Napa Valley

Tasting Notes: Aromas of white peach, apple, pear and honeysuckle. Flavors of passion fruit followed by melon. Bright and supple texture. **11/glass**

Y. Rousseau 2010 Old Vines Colombar

Appellation: Russian River Valley

Tasting Notes: Aromas of lime and citrus with a faint hint of tarragon and ginger. Crisp in acidity with flavors of citrus fruits, pear and honeysuckle flavor. **11/glass**

Cade 2010 Sauvignon Blanc

Appellation: Napa Valley

Tasting Notes: Alive with vibrant, fresh acidity, wonderful aromas of spearmint, guava, kiwi and gooseberry followed on the palate with flavors of lemon/lime and fig. **13/glass**

Palmina 2010 Malvasia Bianca Larner Vineyard

Appellation: Santa Ynez Valley

Tasting Notes: Notes of honeyed melon and white peach with a hint of mango. In the mouth, medium-bodied, refreshing and stunningly beautiful. **15/glass**

Ojai 2009 Viognier Roll Ranch Vineyard

Appellation: Ventura County

Tasting Notes: Unctuous and almost creamy with aromas of orange peel and gardenia, the vibrant acidity lifts the long finish up. **15/glass**

Kent Rasmussen 2007 Chardonnay

Appellation: Napa Valley

Tasting Notes: Rich and complex with bright apple, tropical fruit and toasty oak characteristics. Medley of spice notes, celery-seed, cinnamon and vanilla with a round mouthfeel. **13/glass**

The nose has earth, leather, tobacco with chalky tannins lending a clean finish. 13/glass</p>	<p>Ampelos 2005 Syrah "Gamma" Appellation: Santa Rita Hills Tasting Notes: Nose of toasted oak and dark cherry followed by a palate of almonds, orange peel and dark chocolate. 15/glass</p>

Dark berry flavors are touched with pretty floral aromas and kissed with sweet caramel oak. 14/glass</p>	<p>Esoterica 2008 Petite Sirah Appellation: Rutherford Tasting Notes: Deep dark aromas of blackberry, violets and roasted coffee lead to a silky smooth mouth-coating richness, hints of vanilla and sweet toasty oak in the finish. 15/glass</p>	<p>Aia 2007 Red Blend Appellation: Napa Valley Tasting Notes: Rich in color with beautiful floral aromas on the nose and supple, plummy fruit on the palate. Impressive smoothness in the finish. 16/glass</p>

Subtle spice and sandalwood interplay with notes of fresh soil and forest floor. 15/glass</p>	<p>Kenneth Volk 2008 Pinot Noir Appellation: Santa Barbara Tasting Notes: Strawberry, cherry and rhubarb aromas, then flavors of ripe red fruits, green tea and Asian spices compose this succulent wine. 14/glass</p>	<p>Talley Estate 2009 Pinot Noir Appellation: Arroyo Grande Tasting Notes: Perfumed nose of cola, dark fruits, dried herbs and smoke, silky mid-palate and finishes with well-defined, chalky tannins and refreshing acidity. 16/glass</p>

Rounded out with soft tannins and a clean finish. 15/glass</p>	<p>Ehlers 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon "One twenty over eighty" Appellation: Napa Valley Tasting Notes: Mixed berries, plum, spice & mocha with velvety cocoa, dark currant & maple on the lengthy finish. A non-profit & organic vineyard. 16/glass</p>
